GINA GALETTI SCHOLARSHIP

Established 1988

The Gina Galetti Scholarship is available through the University of Central Missouri Foundation for an active member of Sigma Kappa social sorority, Sigma Phi Epsilon social fraternity, a dependent child living with an IAFF Local 42 member in good standing, a graduate of North Kansas City High School, or a current student pursuing a degree at UCM. This scholarship is made possible by way of a gift from friends and family in memory of Gina Galetti.

SCHOLARSHIP BACKGROUND:

This scholarship was established to honor the memory of Gina Galetti, a UCM student majoring in Public Relations. Gina was an active member of Sigma Kappa social sorority, Sigma Phi Epsilon - golden heart, and served on the Panhellenic Council.

CRITERIA:

To apply, a student must:

- A. Be a full-time student in good academic standing at UCM;
- B. Be an active member of Sigma Kappa social sorority; Sigma Phi Epsilon social fraternity; dependent child living with a firefighter and who is a member of IAFF Local 42 in good standing (International Association of Firefighters); a graduate of North Kansas City High School or a currently enrolled full-time student at UCM;
- C. Demonstrates good character, leadership and service;
- D. Be actively involved in campus and community activities.
- * Preference shall be given to a member of Sigma Kappa social sorority; Sigma Phi Epsilon social fraternity; dependent child of an IAFF Local 42 member in good standing or a graduate of North Kansas City High School.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1. The recipient(s) of the Gina Galetti Scholarship will be recommended by a selection committee comprised of 1) a representative(s) of the Galetti family; 2) alumni of Delta Eta Chapter of Sigma Kappa; 3) the senior Sigma Kappa Panhellenic representative; 4) an active member of the Sigma Kappa Scholarship Fund Committee; 5) alumni of Missouri Theta Chapter of Sigma Phi Epsilon; 6) the Sigma Phi Epsilon Interfraternity Council representative; and 7) an active member of the Sigma Phi Epsilon Scholarship Fund Committee. Seven members of the designated committee shall constitute a quorum. The recipient(s) shall be approved by the UCM Scholarships and Awards Officer.
- 2. The application must be delivered or mailed no later than Friday, April 3rd, 2020.
- 3. The Selection Committee, with the approval of the donor and the Executive Director of the Foundation, will annually establish the number and award amount. If adequate funding is not available, the Selection Committee may exercise the option of making no selection.
